international students are unavailable at this time, several departmental and general scholarships are available. Competition is keen among U.S. and international students, but we encourage you to strive for one or more of these awards for which you may qualify.

The Missouri State Association of International Students (AIS) gives small annual activity awards to AIS international student members who are actively involved in AIS and maintain strong grade point averages.

Although United States or state government sponsored financial aid in the form of loans or grants is unavailable to international students, Missouri State does provide a small short-term loan fund for emergencies. These funds must be repaid within the same semester they were borrowed.

Graduate Assistantships (GA's) are available for qualifying graduate students. GA's pay full-time course fees plus a stipend for living expenses. Books and required health insurance must be paid for by the student from the stipend. GA's are usually awarded in the spring for the fall semester; however, occasionally, there are a few openings for the spring semester. Few GA's are available during the summer session.
